



Tournament conditions - Credit Suisse Gold Pro-Am - Wednesday 25th August 2021

Format - Modified Scramble

The Pro-Am will be a stroke play competition played under the "Modified Scramble" format.

- It will consist of 52 teams of 1 professional and 3 amateurs with the **NET AGGREGATE TEAM SCORE IN RELATION TO PAR** counting at each hole (i.e. ALL 4 scores in the team can count).
- Each player however will have "**par as their friend**" (i.e. The worst score any player can have on a hole is a **net** par so to contribute to the team score a player must score a **net birdie or better**).
- Total scoring will be in relation to par. (i.e. 3 net birdies and one net bogey on a hole = -3 (3 under) as the team score).
- The team with the lowest **net** aggregate score in relation to par will win.

The "**Modified Scramble**" format is similar to a Texas scramble:

- The professional shall always play his own ball.
- The best amateur tee shot will be selected, then all amateurs shall play their own ball from here.
- After the second shots, (this could be a putt on a par 3), each player continues and completes the hole with his own ball.

** NB. In the event of a hole-in-one, only the player who records the hole-in-one can return this score for the hole and the **next best** tee shot of his/her team will be selected as the tee shot from where the remaining team members will play their second shots. (If the selected tee shot is **on the putting green** all players to **place** their ball within **one scorecard's length** of the position of the selected tee shot, not nearer the hole. Anywhere else on the course, all players to **place** their ball within **one club's length** of the position of the selected tee shot, not nearer the hole).

The amateurs' handicap is limited to 24. Amateurs will receive 3/4 handicap allowance up to a maximum of 18 strokes for male amateurs and 24 strokes for female amateurs. Slope system applied.

There is no professional individual event.

NB: As soon as a player cannot contribute with a net birdie or better, he/she should pick up

Field

The professional field will be made up as follows:

- 26 tournament invitations;
- 26 European Tour players.

The Credit Suisse Gold Pro-Am is reserved to persons invited by the sponsors of the Omega European Masters.

Prizes for the Amateurs

For the top 3 teams of the morning, and top 3 teams of the afternoon, based on the format above.
